Candidate Sahlin Projects Views On Education

Paul E. Sahlin, 120 Westchester way, Birmingham, one of the six candidates for the single vacancy on the Birmingham board of education this week made the following statement regarding his candidacy: "I seek membership on the board of education, City of Birmingham, Mich., because of my past experience as a school board official in Cook county, Ill., from 1949 thru 1953. I am fully acquainted with the duties of this office and the responsibility of trusteeship.

"I know that there are numerous unmentioned phases to deal with in properly executing the high standards of this assignment, which I believe many people are not aware of.

"IF I AM elected, I would, as a qualified member, insist upon an immediate study of our tax picture with the other members of the board. In a recent survey which I made, spot checking the city of Birmingham, I heard from the taxpayers personally.

"Fellow citizens invited me into their living rooms and wanted to talk about our increasing school taxes and claims of outrageous, unnecessary and ridiculous de-

mands upon the taxpayers for school funds. Their question, 'What can be done to halt further increases?'

"While no one really can assume the responsibility for the additional students entering our schools every new semester, I do believe that the trustees of the school board must not rely too much on outside pressure and begin to formulate their own needs from experts, and if needed to call in top educators of the state of Michigan for projective views.

"THIS I WOULD propose to the other school board members, if I were elected to serve. I have, through past experience, been confronted with problems of the same nature, and a survey made by Dr. Reaves of the University of Chicago provided us with many answers we sought. The fee was nominal and the results most satisfactory.

"I should also like to have the members of the school board make a complete study of teachers' contracts. I have been led to believe that teachers making a career of their teaching profession are accorded some allowance as tempo-

rary and substitute teachers. I believe in a separate policy providing greater advantages for the career teacher.

"If I am elected I shall make every effort on my part to serve my fellow citizens to the utmost."
