

Concert Attraction De Paor Opera Gala

An exciting new concert attraction has been launched by Community Concerts, which presents the de Paor Opera Gala in Royal Oak Dondoro high school auditorium Friday, March 22, at 8:15 p.m. under the auspices of South Oakland County Community Concerts association.

For the first time, American audiences will hear excerpts from three Broadway operatic successes, under the direction of Leonard de Paor, conductor of the de Paor Infantry chorus, which has disbanded in favor of the new company.



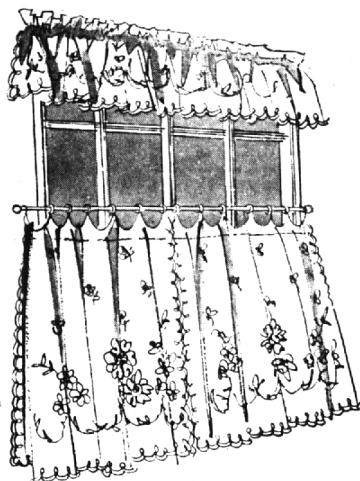

The operas are "Four Saints in Three Acts" with its witty libretto by Gertrude Stein and sparkling music by Virgil Thomson; the electric Hammerstein-Rizet "Carmen Jones" and the American classic "Porgy and Bess" by George Gershwin.

LAWRENCE Winters, leading baritone of the New York City opera, will be the singing star in "Porgy and Bess". Other notable principals are Ivez Matthews, mezzo soprano, and Luther Saxon, tenor soloist. A baritone soloist with the chorus, George Marshall, will also assume solo roles with the Opera Gala.

The brilliant aggregation consists of a company of 50, including an orchestra of 25, a mixed chorus and soloist. No scenery or costumes

are projected, as the attraction presents highlights from these three smash hits in concert form. Leonard de Paor's high reputation in the world of music enabled him to secure the rights to give these excerpts, many of which have never been heard in concert before.
