

### Island View Vacation Must Start Anew

A new start will be required on any vacation of undeveloped Island View drive, the Birmingham city commission ordered Monday night.

It denied without prejudice Charles Van Horn's petition that the drive be vacated to permit development of an off-street parking area behind proposed business structures.

The drive is located east of Woodward along the Rouge riverbank north of Park street.

CITY ATTORNEY Richard Adams recommended this denial be made so Van Horn could petition circuit court for permission to abandon the drive.

When this matter was before the commission four weeks ago, former mayor and commissioner Madison F. Mallester, representing Brookside residents, pointed out a little-known Michigan statute he claimed required circuit court approval for vacation of any highway adjacent to a lake or stream.

Adams advised the commission to stay on the safe side and deny Van Horn's petition without prejudice. Van Horn did not indicate whether he would petition the court.

Brookside residents, who overlook the city-owned island east of the Van Horn development, object to anything which would destroy the natural beauty of the valley at that point.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a special election will be held in the School District of the City of Birmingham in the County of Oakland, and the State of Michigan, on Monday, the 25th day of March, 1957, from 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M., Eastern Standard Time, to vote upon the following proposition:

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed each year against property in the School District of the City of Birmingham, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, for all purposes except taxes for the payment of interest and principal on obligations incurred prior to December 8, 1952, be increased as provided in Section 21 of Article X of the Constitution of Michigan, for a period of five (5) years from 1957 to 1961, both inclusive, by 6 10ths of 1% (\$6.00 per \$1,000) of the assessed valuation as equalized, for the purpose of paying a part of the operating expenses of the school district?
