TO VOTE ON A NEW CHARTER COMMISSION

Whereas, heretofore on December 18, 1956, pursuant to Act 279 of the Public Acts of 1909, as amended, a petition was filed by certain resident electors and freeholders of the area, praying for a New Charter Commission,

That the form and sufficiency of the petition heretofore filed on December 18, 1956, praying for a New Charter Commission for the City to be known as 'Southfield' to consist of the territory described in said petition, complies with the provisions of the Act, being Act 279 of the Public Acts of 1990, as amended, and are in all respects regular;

That April 1, 1957 be set as the date for a Special Election for a New Charter Commission for the City of Southfield.

TO VOTE FOR THE FOLLOWING NINE (9) CHARTER COMMISSIONERS

NOTICE RELATIVE TO OPENING AND CLOSING OF THE POLLS

ELECTION LAW, ACT 116, P. A. 1954

SECTION 720. On the day of any election the polls shall be opened at 7 o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be continuously open until 8 o'clock in the afternoon and no longer. Every qualified elector present and in line at the polls at the loar preseribed for the closing thereof shall be allowed to vote.
