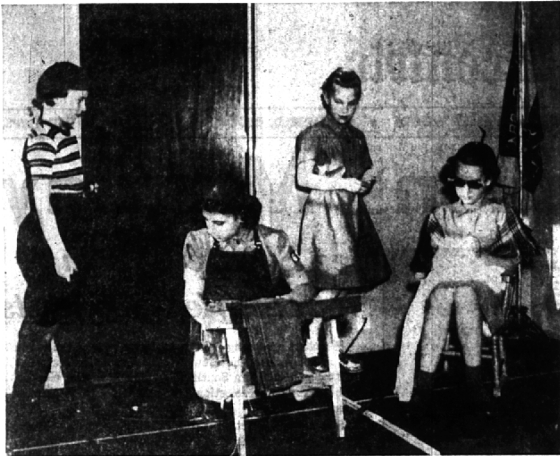


# Brownies, Girl Scouts Observe 45th Birthday

# Hearing on Sewer Injunction Friday

**SOUTHFIELD** — Hearing on a restraining order which has halted construction of a sewer in a subdivision west of Greenfield road north of 12 Mile road, has been postponed until Friday.

And Wednesday Supervisor Eric Swern will appear before the State board of health in defense of the issuance of the permit to construct the 24-inch sewer.

Swern, State official in charge of the sewer's construction, Derkey, which was granted the injunction complained that additional building would continue to overload its already overburdened sewer, causing continued basement flooding.

Some 50 homes in the Meadowdale subdivision, owned by Silvio Hoffes of Detroit, are affected by the injunction.
