## Open New Men's Grill At B'ham Country Club

BIRMINGHAM — A major expansion and improvement program at Birmingham country club was completed this week with opening of a new men's grill of striking design.

For men members, the handsome two-level grill amounts to a "club within a club" at Birmingham. With approximately 6,000 square feet of space and seating capacity for 140 persons, it has its own kitchen—completely separate from the club house kitchen—plus a recreation and utility room in the basement.

On three sides of the room large thermopane picture windows permit a view of the first tee and part of the Birmingham course where the national PGA championship was played in 1953.

OF OPEN BEAM construction, the grill interior is of Oregon cedar and Tennessee ledge rock. Construction of the new grill was begun under 1956 club president Gale Stringer as part of a program to equip the club for complete family participation. Club officials said completion of the expansion and modernization program makes Birmingham one of the most outstanding clubs in this part of the country.

THE PROGRAM ALSO included construction of a swimming pool and a new shower room, and air conditioning the club house. Completion of the grill permitted expansion of the men's locker room by 64 lockers. Naming and formal dedication of the grill room are planned for later in the season. Arthur Zebedeo is the current club president. Club golf professional is F. Ray McGuire.

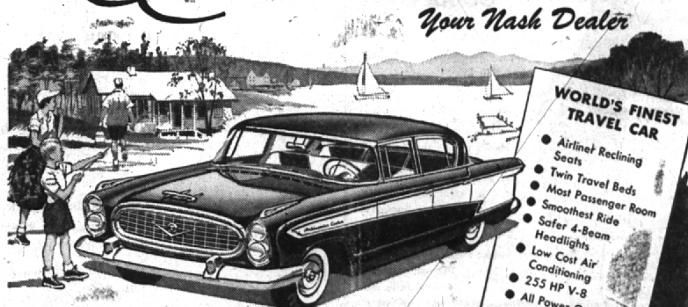

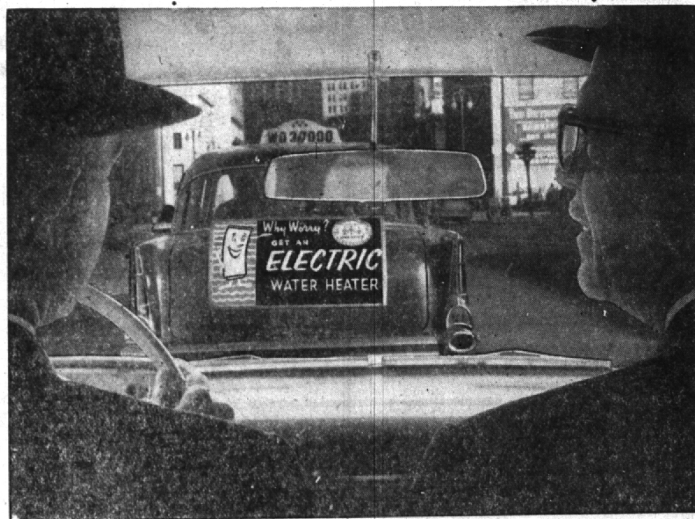
