Tonight young voices will join in Birmingham high school's 19th annual spring concert by the choir, under the direction of Victor Ulrich.

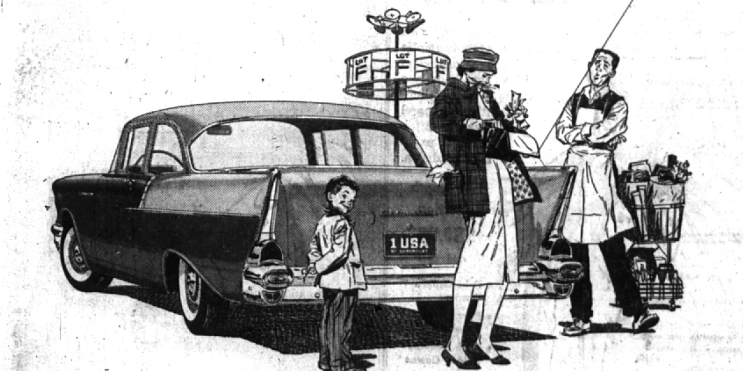
Approximately 150 singers will present a varied program in the high school gym at 8 p.m. Donald Odie and Brenda Gross, will be soloists.
