**Says the Barrister**  
 You never realized how important it is to an accused to be tried in a county where tempers of local residents have not been inflamed. The law has faith in local people to do justice in local cases. But once in a while the place in which the trial is to be held works against a fair verdict. So our laws carefully define the "venue" the place where a criminal case is to be brought to trial.  
 When we read of a change of venue, it's generally in connection with a criminal case, but the venue can be changed in civil matters, too, like when there's a relationship between the judge and one of the parties or attorneys, or where there is a personal interest, etc.  
 Where a court has jurisdiction in a criminal case, a change of venue may be ordered by the judge upon a showing of good cause. He can direct that the case be tried in the circuit court of another county. That's what the law says.  
**THE CIRCUIT** judge, to whom a petition for a change in venue is presented, has the sole right to determine if the case should be tried, say, in the next county. Even the supreme court wouldn't upset his judgment unless it could be proved that he abused his discretion.  
 Here's something of interest in case you're thinking of expenses to the county where a criminal case is transferred to your county. The law says . . . in all cases when the defendant shall be convicted and sentenced to imprisonment in the county jail or to pay a fine, or to both such imprisonment and fine, the court awarding such sentence shall have authority to direct and shall direct that the defendant be imprisoned in the county jail or in the county in which such prosecution commenced; and that such fine, when paid, shall be paid over to the county treasurer of the county in which such prosecution commenced, in the same manner as is now provided by law for paying over fines to county treasurers; and in every case where a change of venue is ordered.
