Separated System Proposed

LATHRUP—Construction of separated storm and sanitary sewerage systems was recommended Monday by Robert Norris of Ayers, Lewis, Norris, and May, Ann Arbor engineers.

Cost of the total project was estimated at \$961,000 with a yearly cost of \$84,840. A combined system would cost \$1,085,500 with an annual fixed charge of \$109,200.
