

Boy, 11, Dies After Fall From Bicycle

Found lying on the sidewalk beneath the bicycle from which he had tumbled, an 11-year-old Birmingham boy was pronounced dead on arrival after being rushed to William Beaumont hospital Sunday at 5 p.m.

A witness said he saw James V. Skelley, of 1176 Shipman boulevard, immediately after he fell in front of Mulholland's store, 233 N. Woodward. Because the boy was found for breath, an ambulance was called. An autopsy later revealed death was caused by suffocation from food particles lodged in the boy's windpipe.

James was a student at Valley Woods school and a member of Cub Scouts Pack B-29. He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. James Skelley; a brother, John; two sisters, Catherine and Sister James Ellen of Monroe; and his grandmother, Mrs. John Meyer of Williamsport, Pa. Rosary services were Tuesday evening with funeral services Wednesday from Our Lady Queen of Martyrs church. Burial was in Holy Sepulchre cemetery.
