The controversy which has erupted in Detroit high school athletic circles over the ineligibility of a Denby football star and the resulting forfeiture of games and loss of a champion-hip could have happened only in Detroiter.

All Michigan high schools except those in Detroit are governed with a firm hand by the Michigan High School Athletic association, established in 1926 and headed by Charles E. Forsythe. Detroit broke from the MHSAA shortly after it was formed, and while MHSAA rules are closely followed, and advice from the association often requested, the Motor dity's public schools have their own board of control, empowered to make decisions in cases such as this.

THE ORIGINAL RULING of the City league board left to Denby player in question ineligible for the remainder of is high school career because of the forged doctor's signare on a medical exam. It did not, however, take undefeated enby's victories away.

The mother of the athlete involved, however, requested a cond hearing. As a result, the board restored one semester eligibility and reversed its previous decision by ordering in Denby wins forfeited.
