New Phone Book Delivery Starts Here Next Week
Next week Friday, the 1957-58 edition of the telephone directory will make its appearance in the homes and business establishments in Birmingham and in the Mayfair exchange, according to Albert H. Warner, manager here for the Michigan Bell Telephone Company. Warner had some suggestions on how to make best use of the new directories.
He said, "Be certain to write police and fire numbers on the first page in the large spaces reserved for such numbers. This will speed emergency aid when needed." He commented that children should be shown where these important numbers are.
WARNER SAID that Michigan Bell had ordered 33,800 copies printed for Birmingham, an increase of 2,200 copies over the number required for distribution last year; and 8,600 copies of the Mayfair edition, an increase of 500 over last year's edition.
The Birmingham book includes listings for Pontiac, Royal Oak, Southfield, Troy and Mayfair. The Mayfair directory on the other hand, includes separate listings for Birmingham, Farmington, Pontiac, Southfield and West Lake.
