Robert Casadesu: A Distinguished Pianist

Robert Casadesu and the Detroit Symphony played together in a concert last Thursday evening at the Ford Auditorium and did much to compliment the reputation of each. The program began with the playing of Mozart's "Eine Kleine Nachtmusik" which Paul Paray executed with crispness and aplomb. This set the tone for a concert which was not going to present any problems to the audience. It was a program of Mozart, Liszt, Franck, and André Block (not to be confused with Ernest).

played by the saxophonist with the orchestra. The climax of the evening was provided by Casadesu's playing of the Franck Symphonic Variations for Piano and Orchestra. THIS ONE movement form has a subtlety and continuity wholly missing in Liszt's. It gave Casadesu ample opportunity to demonstrate not only a fine and meticulous technique, but a clearly thought out interpretation which never sagged into a saccharine mush.

NEITHER of these pianistic works when they are played together. He plays both easily, intelligently, and forcibly. But we must wait till the next time and hope that he sees fit to fashion a program for himself that will better display his real genius—the music of Mozart, Bach, Scarlatti, Debussy, Ravel, Stravinsky, or Prokofiev. Not every frock becomes the most beautiful woman—nor every period of music the most gifted artist.
