ing to college, though he had no money," she said. "Ray might have been stuck forever in a little West Virginia town."

To learn if dreams are right and God's help can be asked for them, she listed several measures. First she said, the dream must be in accordance with our own being and capabilities.

SECONDLY, it must be in accordance with God's laws, not including any person or thing that belongs to anyone else, or resentments or jealousies.

Third, you must want it enough to work as hard as necessary to bring it about; fourth, you must have patience.

She applied to the United States her belief in God's helping dreams that are right.

"The USA was the result of a dream big enough for God to bless," she said. "I have had an uneasy feeling lately that this is a dream we are going to have to reapture."

"WE ARE GOING to have to decide whether we value this dream more than we value materialism," she added.

"But I have little doubt but what Americans will decide the right way, because though we love our things, we also love our freedom more than any people on earth."
