Named Director For Chrysler

John von Rosen, 435 Linden, has been named director of manufacturing engineering for Chrysler Corp. In his new capacity, von Rosen

will be in charge of the corporation's production, industrial and plant engineering activities. Von Rosen, who has been director of plant engineering for the company since 1952, first joined Chrysler in 1927. During the next four years, while attending the University of Detroit as a cooperative student, he worked in various Detroit plants of Chrysler.

HE JOINED the company as a full time employee in 1932 when he became a plant layout engineer at Plymouth. He was named assistant plant engineer at the Plymouth plant in 1938 and four years later became the division's plant engineer.

From 1949 to 1952 he served on the staff of the vice president and general manager of Chrysler, handling special assignments in connection with plant construction.

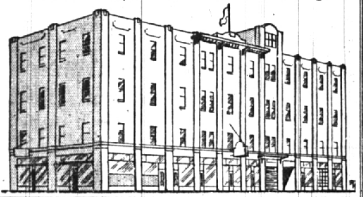

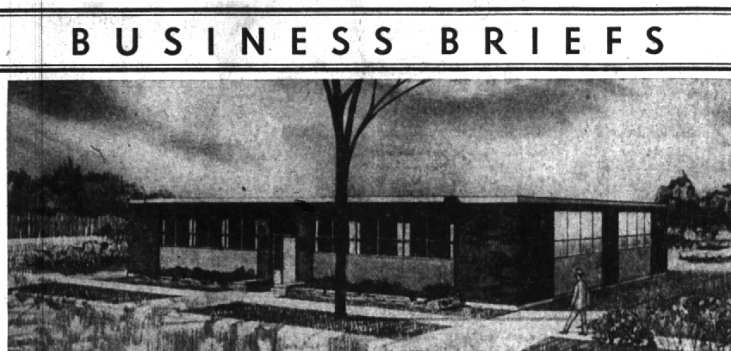
