Does Your Maid Know for Whom She Is Working?

Does your maid, gardener, chauffeur or baby sitter know where she or he is working, and for whom she or he is working?

No, this isn't a joke. And if you don't believe it, check with your hired help to see if they know where they're working. It's a dead serious problem with Birmingham's firemen.

Believe it or not, it's not unusual for the local fire department to

receive a call from a party, often domestic help, who has no idea at all where the fire is.

RECENTLY a maid at a local home called firemen to report the house was filled with smoke. She did not know the address or even the name of her employer. Firemen waited several minutes while the women went through letters to find an envelope with the home's address on.

Luckily, the trouble was only a faulty dryer. It could have been more serious, and the delay disastrous.

THE INCIDENT, not uncommon, prompted a request from Park II. Smith, Birmingham fire chief, for all home owners to be certain that domestic help know the street and the house number and what fire department to call.

It might save someone a lot of grief.
