"If I were to seek a parallel from my own experience to the proposed Matson Navigation Co. resort development on Maui island, Hawaiian islands, I would say the Del Monte lodge and Pebble Beach community on California's Monterey peninsula."

So said David S. Geer, founder and principal of Geer Associates, Bloomfield Hills, today in commenting on his firm's recent engagement to do site planning for the fabulous new resort area.

Located on the southwest coast of Maui, the central island of the Hawaiian group, the area will encompass a 1,500 acre resort town centered about a 100-room luxury hotel, with nearby cottage accommodations.

"LIKE PEBBLE BEACH," Geer of Long Lake road, added, "the proposed resort will benefit from ideal climate, dry and brilliantly sunny, magnificent scenery, and the recreational opportunities offered by the Pacific ocean."

"Pebble Beach, which began with the dream of a single man, S. F. B. Morse, nephew of the inventor of the telephone, added to the natural attractions of climate, scenery and ocean, the standards of service and recreational facilities which a fine resort hotel can offer a surrounding community."

"Here, as on Maui, the resort will serve, one might say, as a civic center for a whole community of permanent residents."

"AND AS ON the Monterey peninsula, as a whole, the attraction of the fine homes of Pebble Beach radiated outward to affect Carmel and other communities, hastening their growth with more moderate sized homes."

"Thus the whole growth pattern and economic level of Maui could well be affected by the nucleus of a truly fine resort development. Despite the similarities, however, we recognize that each land development we plan is a new challenge."

Each is different, but each has some aspects in common with the others.

"Just as the advent of the automobile has spurred the development of the Monterey peninsula in California, so I am convinced, will the rapidly approaching jet aircraft usher in a new era for the Hawaiian Islands."

"WHEN ONE THINKS that in a few years, jet air travel will place the islands within very brief flying time of almost the entire United States, one begins to see, if only dimly, the potential for both tourists and permanent settlers."

"I can say in all candor that of the many resort development plans I have worked on in both the United States and Canada, I cannot recall one that has so inspired me with its potential and which I believe, has so successful a future."

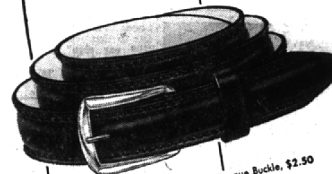

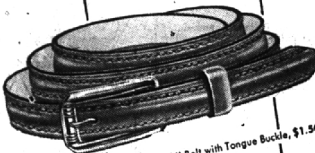

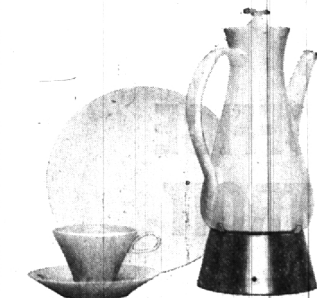
