Exhibit Center Opening Here October 26

The Midwest's first permanent exhibit center for home building products, to be located in Birmingham, is scheduled to open to the public Saturday, October 26.

Remodeling work has already started on the former moving company warehouse at 136 Brownell Street which will house the new display center.

Called "showcase" by its owners, Showcase, Inc., the 12,500 square foot building has exhibit space for more than 300 products, all on one floor.

"OUR FUNCTION is not a selling one, but one of bringing manufacturers' products to the home buying public," said George Puddington, president. Mrs. Mildred E. Puddington, with many years of business experience in Detroit, is treasurer of the company.

"No salesmen will pitch from the displays. Tag management of Showcase provides trained personnel for the convenience of visitors, and these personnel will act as walking information centers on the exhibited products.

Law Protects Motorists From Uninsured Drivers

Michigan motorists are protected from becoming involved in accidents. Every owner or operator of a motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in an injury or death or in damage in excess of \$100 to the property of any one person must make a report immediately to the Michigan secretary of state.

These reports must be filled out and mailed to the division of driver and vehicle services, Michigan department of state, Lansing, Mich. within 10 days after the accident.

FAILURE to report within this time constitutes a misdemeanor and sufficient ground for the suspension of a person's license and registration.

If a person fails to give information on injuries on the report and does not do so within 60 days after the accident, the secretary of state cannot require an uninsured motorist to post cash or a bond of security.

The forms can be obtained from the police department or from an insurance company.

These reports are in addition to the reports kept by the local police department which has records of all accidents far back into the years.

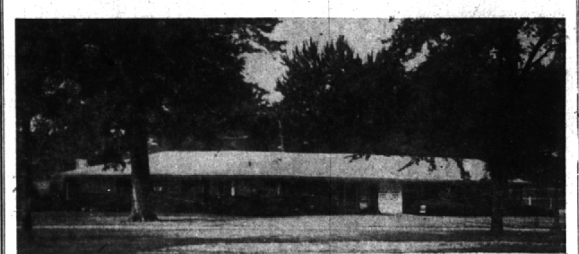
Barricades Back At Adams School
