

### Cranbrook Offers Evening Classes In Art for Adults

CRANBROOK—Wallace Mitchell, head of Cranbrook academy of art galleries, has announced two ten-week evening classes in drawing and painting for adults, beginning Tuesday, Oct. 8 and Thursday, Oct. 10.

Fred Mitchell, academy painting instructor, will teach the Tuesday class for beginners, and an advanced course Thursdays for students who have developed the ability to work independently but wish to explore new directions and techniques.

Classes will be held in the academy art library, adjoining the galleries, from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.

### Therapy Meeting Monday in Flint

The Southeastern Michigan Horticultural Therapy Council will have its September workshop in Flint at the Genesee County Tuberculosis Sanatorium on Monday, September 30, at 9:30.

In Oakland County there will be at least fifty volunteer workers sponsored by garden clubs, hospital auxiliaries, and churches who will attend this meeting for the training of new volunteers.

This program introduces a twelve month schedule of using plant material which can include cut flowers, cuttings house plants and outdoor gardens towards the goal of aiding patients who are mentally and physically ill.

These volunteers in Oakland County work in homes for the aged, Oakland County Convalescent home and Pontiac hospital.

Classes open next Thursday in the Christopher leadership course to be conducted at Our Lady Queen of Martyrs parish, 16243 Dunblaine, Birmingham. The nine evening sessions begin at 7:30 p.m. according to Rev. Father Brennan, director of the Christopher career guidance school, which conducts the same course in seven other locations.

City of Birmingham Sidewalk Ordinance No. 354, requires that the notice be given, stating the City's intention to make this improvement. However, the ordinance states that the work may be done by the contractor at his own expense, provided the work is completed within 25 days from the date of this notice in accordance with Commission Resolution No. 848, 1957, which authorized the work. The Ordinance provides that the work shall be done in conformity with the specifications of the Engineering Department of the City and that a permit shall be secured prior to construction of the sidewalk.

The City is preparing to let a contract for sidewalk construction, and in the event the property owner does not cause the sidewalk to be constructed within 25 days from the date of this notice, the City will proceed to have the work constructed by its contractor and assess the cost against the property owner.

In the sidewalk replacement work a year ago, the cost assessed by the City for 4 inch thick concrete walk replacement was \$195 per square foot. It is estimated that the cost will be approximately the same this year.
