Bequests Augment Cranbrook Museum Scientific Items

CRANBROOK — The late W. Nelson Whittemore, a resident of Bloomfield Hills, was long a generous donor to the mineralogical collections at Cranbrook Institute of Science.

By the terms of his will, the mineral collection he had built up privately over many years was left to the Institute, and last July Dr. Robert Y. Hart, Institute director, went to Santa Barbara to choose the 2000 specimens from the Whittemore collection which will be worked into the collections at the Institute over the next several months.

A second bequest which augments the Institute's collections in three fields, came through the will of the late Fred Dustin, distinguished amateur scientist of Saginaw.

The Institute has received Mr. Dustin's geological and mineralogical collections, as well as his named collection of fresh-water mollusks. During Mr. Dustin's lifetime, the Institute received many of his finest collections in these fields, and in the field of archeology.
