Bloomfield Hills football team has been practicing twice a day but today begins workouts on a once a day basis. The Hills varsity wound up with a '56 record of five wins and three losses. The junior varsity held a record of four wins and two losses.

The Barons lost a conference championship in a 13-7 game with Frazer when two Hills touchdowns were called back for penalties.

Hoff says the line is shaping up good this year despite loss of Tom Little, 200 pounder now attending Ohio Wesleyan U. Another valuable player lost was Jay Miller, attending Stamford now.
