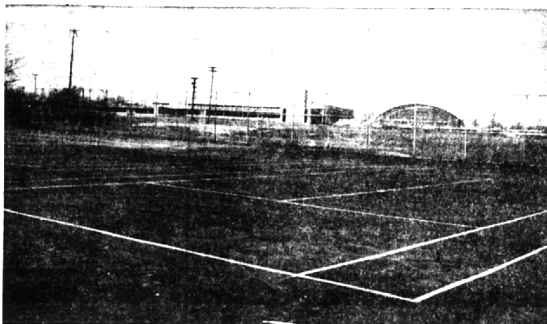

Spring Critical Fire Period

The arrival of spring in Michigan is the signal for forest fire prevention measures as the state enters its most critical fire period.

Early springtime creates serious hazards because foliage is still dormant and fires spread rapidly before "green-up" time. High winds during this season of the year also mean trouble—often causing small fires to rage out of control.

M. M. Beaman, head of the conservation department's fire control section, points out that more than 50 per cent of spring fires are caused by persons burning debris—particularly in rural areas. Precautions are necessary to prevent these small fires from spreading to nearby vegetation and wooded areas.

BEAMAN ADVISES landowners, to observe safety recommendations, including: (1) Never set a fire when winds are high; (2) Do not set fires during the day, but until late afternoon or evening when humidity is high and winds are down; (3) Always have had tools and assistance available for stopping a fire.

Through March 23, fire alone had damaged 152 acres of state and private forests and grassland in Michigan. The loss included 112 acres burned in the southern lower peninsula, 20 acres in the northern lower peninsula and 20 acres in the upper peninsula.

HEAVIEST LOSSES to date were recorded in the Inland City district. In recent weeks, which includes the Thumb area and counties surrounding Detroit. Damage in this district through March 23 totaled 84 acres.
