• Thin Legs • Club Foot • Rain Water • Warts

Q. Will exercise improve thin legs?

A. Yes. According to one doctor, the size of the legs can be increased by weight-resistance exercises. "Free" exercises, he says, without weight resistance is not nearly as effective. This may be true but ballet dancers acquire well developed legs by "free" exercises. They spend hours on end doing "squats" or plies. With the back erect and the head up, the knees and hips are fully flexed until the dancer is in a full knees-bent position.
