APRIL AFTERTHOUGHTS

- 1. Scatter annual poppy seeds where you want
- 2. Spray or dust delphiniums, holly-hocks, phlox as soon as they start to grow—Use BORDEAUX or CAPTAN.
- 3. Cut back all your roses to LIVE wood and fur-ther for less but bigger blooms.
- Screening vines such as scarlet runner, kudzu, c., should be planted now. 5. Divide delphiniums now. Three (3) good crowns with a good root are sufficient.
- 6. Plant LILIES now-AURATUM, REGAL, CENTIFOLIUM, etc.
- 7. If lilies, especially Regals, get going too fast put a little marsh hay or straw over them until May 15th.
- GLADIOLUS can be planted outdoors. Plant ome every 2 weeks for a succession of blooms.
- 10. CRABGRASS pre-energence controls should be soread now—May 5th may be the last date. Use 72% chlordane.
- 11. 1-year old asparagus roots are best. Pre-pare bed according to instructions. 25 for \$1.50.
- 12. For the finy black bugs coming in droves spray the house foundation and the ground for 10 ft. from the house with MALATHION. Maybe 2 or 3 applications will be required.
- 13. Prune evergreen, arborvitae, box and yew before growth begins. Remove ONLY last year's unless you know what you are doing. We don't.
- 11. Don't worry about the galls on spruce at this time. But get busy in May and June. Watch for life IN the plant and annual life ON the plant, then sorray with MALATHION once a week for 5 feeks.
- a week for a rece.

 15. LAWN:—
 a. Fertilize 3 times a year.
 b. Set mower at 2"—not less than 112".
 c. Put 1" of water on lawn once a week and not more—unless you want bent grass.
- 16. Use 10-6-4 on lawns, trees and shrubs. Use 5-10-5 or 4-12-4 on flower and vecetable gardens. Use driconure as a superior conditioner and wild fertilizer on gardens.
- 17. If peonybuds turned black before opening it 16. It peonytous turned black before opening it was probably due to bortytis—a fungus disease. Sorav with BORDEAUX or CAPTAN. With the latter use 3 ounces to 10 gallons of water and spray 3 times, two weeks apart, as soon as they come through the rye—that is the ground.

 2. Gibrellic Acid in a spray bomb or in a kit from which you prepare your own solution for flowers, permanent waves, or said dressing. Miraculous!

 3. Sequestrene is a wonderful material to use when it is needed. The primary place is when trees and plants have chlorosis (lack of iron) (yellowing).
- 4. PET NAIL FILES.
- Japanese brass flower holders, iron dishes, lovely tapered vases and—
- 6. Garden fountains and figures and pumps to make the figures fount.
- 7. MINIATURE ROSE BUSHES—8" high— \$1.79.

- 1. Fertilizing of the lawn is the most important immediate activity. Use a 10-6-4 fertilizer at a rate of 100 lbs. to 5,000 sq. ft. Don't use lime unless your soil has been tested and indicates a need for
- 2. Apply 72% chlordane before May 10th as a re-emergence control for crabgrass.
