Michael Vettrano Head Gardener At Cranbrook

Rosary service will be held at 8 p.m. today at the Venable Bailey funeral home for Michael Vettrano, who was head of the large gardening staff of the Cranbrook Institutions.

Mr. Vettrano, 75, died Tuesday at his residence, 1 Valley road, Bloomfield Hills, after a long illness. When Michael arrived in Detroit in 1945, he was employed as a gardener on rural homestead of George C. Booth.

A brick cottage beside Brookside School Cranbrook was dedicated as "Piazza Vettrano" with a plaque which says the piazza does honor to the man who devoted more than a half century to "preserving and augmenting the beauty of the grounds of Cranbrook."

IT WAS TYPICAL of the growing status of immigrants in general that the best known son, Dominick, beat out a retired vice president of General Motors Corp. to be elected a Bloomfield Hills city commissioner.

Dominick, head of the police, fire and utility departments at Cranbrook, accepted election from his wealthy fellow townsmen by saying, "A man is not a man for what he owns, but for what he is."

HE IS SURVIVED by his wife, the former Marie Anichian, whom he married in Detroit in 1941; Dominick and two other sons, John and Samuel, both of Bloomfield Hills; three daughters, Mrs. Leon Kiehl of Birmingham; Mrs. Connie Ross of Royal Oak and Annette of Bloomfield Hills.

The body will be placed at 9:30 a.m. Friday in St. Hugo of the Holy church, followed by burial in Holy Sepulchre cemetery. Because this is Holy Week, the requiem mass will be sung later at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Hugo's.
