Grass Fires Total 221 in Townships

Five departments in Bloomfield and Southfield townships and Franklin have answered 221 grass fires calls since March 1.

Southfield, with 158 grass fires, has the highest total. Bloomfield township recorded 32 grass fires and Franklin 21.

ANOTHER 21 grass fires in Bloomfield and Southfield Hills brought the area's total to 245. Iveys Celebrate 25th Anniversary


