### It's Back to School Next Month For 17,000 Birmingham Area Pupils

It's back to the text books, the classrooms and the ivy leagues next month for some 17,000 Birmingham area voungsters.

School is reopening.

Before many more days have passed, the corridors of the area's numerous public, private and parochial schools will again be bulging with lads and lassies from 5 to 19, many just back from summer camps, vacation trips or a stay at the cottage.

SEPT. 2 is the key day for Birmingham district schools. Those in Bloomfield Hills open two days later, Sept. 4.

Bir ming ham school district officials expect a registration of 11,109 pupils at public schools here this fall. Another 2,274 from the Birmingham district are expected at private and parochial schools.
