

**Few Simple Rules Make Shoe Care Quick and Easy**

When you go shopping for your children's back-to-school shoes this fall, you'll not only encounter new styles but also a lot of new leathers.

Thanks to new tanning methods, leathers have acquired a new suppleness and light weight, giving new comfort on foot and yet retaining the old durability for which leather is known.

Among these new leathers you'll see smooth highly polished finishes, finely etched textures, soft brushed surfaces and shiny patent leathers.

Leather, like your skin, is composed of millions of tiny pores which allow it to "breathe". And just as the pores of your skin must be kept clean, so must leather. Here are a few rules to follow when cleaning your youngsters'

shoes. Remove all surface dirt with a stiff brush. If smooth leathers are particularly grimy, clean with a mild soap. Then use paste polish or

one of the liquid wax polishes at least once a week. When shoes get wet, let them dry on shoe trees or stuff them with paper. Avoid heat.
