

New Courses Added In Hills' Curriculum

Changes resulting from the separation of junior and senior high school students in two buildings highlight the amended intermediate and secondary curricula in Bloomfield Hills this fall.

With an expected 10th through 12th grade enrollment of 600 replacing last year's 1,050 seventh through 12th graders at Bloomfield Hills high school, more than a dozen new courses will be offered this year, while class load will drop from an average of 35-40 students per section to 25-30. Eight additional teachers will be employed.

New art classes abound, with commercial art, crafts and ceramics and drawing and painting all being offered for the first time.

SECOND YEAR courses will be opened in general shop, typing, shorthand and Latin. A new first year German class will be started.

A foods and clothing course supplements the old homemaking class, with half-year credit now being given in addition to full-year. A half-year speech course is also being included in the curriculum for the first time at BHHS.

Applied mathematics and current affairs sections round out the list of new courses for senior high students.

THE TREND toward more em-

basis on foreign language schooling is being carried on in Bloomfield Hills junior high, where conversational French will be offered in addition to the present conversational Spanish, and even in the grade schools, where elementary French will be taught for the first time.

Other junior high curriculum additions include eighth and ninth grade general science classes and ninth grade speech and typing. More time for non-academic courses and extra-curricular activities will result from the change from a six to eight-period day.

Work of the patrols under the supervision of school authorities and with the cooperation of police has been wonderfully successful in helping bring the school child accident toll down.
