Bloomfield Gets Two New Schools. More Classrooms

Two new schools, a six-class-room addition and 32 new teachers top the list of Bloomfield school's summer revamping program.

The \$1,300,000 Bloomfield Hills junior high school at Quarton road will be opened in September. Accrding to school officials, the access roads should be blacktopped and the landscaping completed for its opening.

PINE LAKE elementary school on Pine Lake road will serve 150 to 200 area children. Landscaping and blacktopping there also should be finished by the time school opens. The approximate expenditure for the structure is \$300,000. The six-room addition to East-over school will accommodate some

150 additional students. Cost for addition is an estimated \$180,000

Thirty-two teachers have been hired to staff the new schools and the Eastover addition.
