Zoning Board To Meet Again At Franklin

FRANKLIN — Although they had only one hearing on their agenda Monday, Franklin's zoning board of appeals did a "land office business" and agreed to set up shop again next Monday.

On the docket Monday, Goldfale market presented plans for remodeling the former Franklin Food shop. There were no objections from neighbors, but the board will have to decide whether to allow an outside stairway to the second story and an extension to the rear of the building.

The board also told John Showers, owner, that he would be required to provide off-street parking for 19 cars.

THE FRANKLIN Volunteer Fire department asked permission to build an addition to the present fire hall. This would make the building exceed present size restrictions of 2500 square feet and violate set-back limitations. The board will hold a public hearing on this Monday.

Count of Cars Set At Franklin School

FRANKLIN — The cars passing the Franklin road-Scenic drive intersection will be counted for three days soon to determine who will pay for a blinker light at the spot.

The village council has agreed to install the light to make the crossing safer for children at the crest of Franklin school hill. The county will pay all or part, depending on the car count.

The light is to be installed early in September.

Franklin Community association, Peter Garwood and Albert Carr, asked the board's opinion on using the present Christian Science church on German Mill road as a community center. It might eventually house the library, village offices and civic groups.

The zoning board advised the association to set forth a definite plan, keeping off-street parking in mind, before a final answer could be given.

Cruiser Damaged In 3-Car Mishap

BLOOMFIELD — A Bloomfield township police cruiser was damaged Tuesday night in a three-car mishap at Square Lake and Woodward.

The cruiser, driven by Patrolman Henry Juntenen, was stopped in the northbound lane waiting to make a turn. It was rammed in the rear by a car driven by Charles T. Welch, 22, of Pontiac. The collision drove the police car into a third auto, driven by 26-year-old Lester M. Blucker of Pontiac.

THERE WERE NO injuries. Damage to the cruiser was estimated at \$100. The Welch car had to be towed away and Welch was ticketed for reckless driving. The third auto was damaged slightly.
