With longer (have you noticed) nights coming the problem of blackspot on roses gets worser. Keep spraying with an all-purpose material such as ORTHO'S ROSE DUST or with CAPTAN or FERMATE. Keep fertilizing the plants once a month with STADLER'S ROSE FOOD as sturdiness of the plant is vital.
