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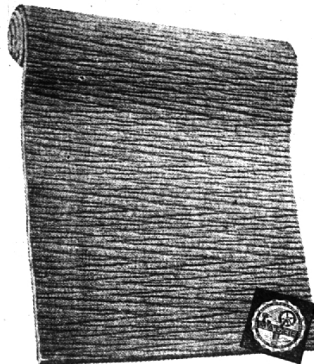


Dyed Russian Broadtail Lamb Coat Natural Ranch Mink Collar, shown 1195 as sketched

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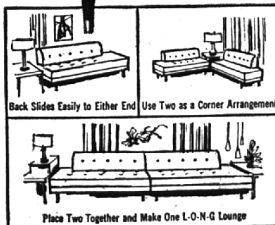
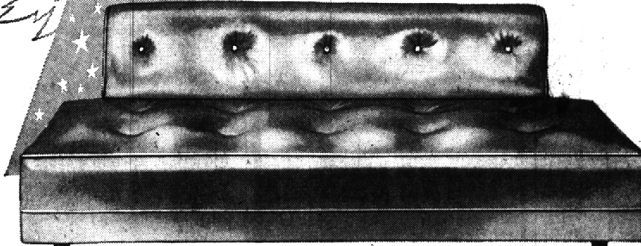
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
