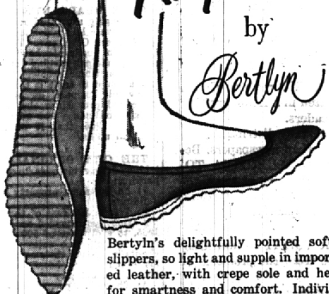

## A Native of B'ham Stars on Broadway

Playing the role of a madman in "Comes the Day," George C. Scott, former journalism student at the University of Michigan, has drawn praise from leading critics in his first appearance on Broadway.

Brooks Atkinson, New York Times critic, called the part Scott "brilliantly calculated performance."

Other praise came from other critics, among them Richard Watts of the New York Post, who said: "The characterization of a man who literally goes mad before your eyes is managed with monstrous power and shocking credibility that the sadist becomes a villain of melodrama but a terrifyingly real human being."

A native of Birmingham, Scott went to Redford high school in Detroit, before attending the University from 1949 to 1952. While here, he won the Mahan Story Prize in 1951, and was also a member of the Purple Mask, honorary dramatic society.

SCOTT'S FIRST role at the University, and his first acting experience, was in "The Winslow Boy," opposite Pat McClarny, New York actress.

In the Starlight Theater, summer workshop of the University dramatics department, Scott was one of two actors ever to appear in both productions of the season.

His versatility was shown by the two roles, that of the juvenile lead in "Show," and of the character in "The Winesap Grove," according to H. Donovan Rhysbray, professor and chairman of the University.
