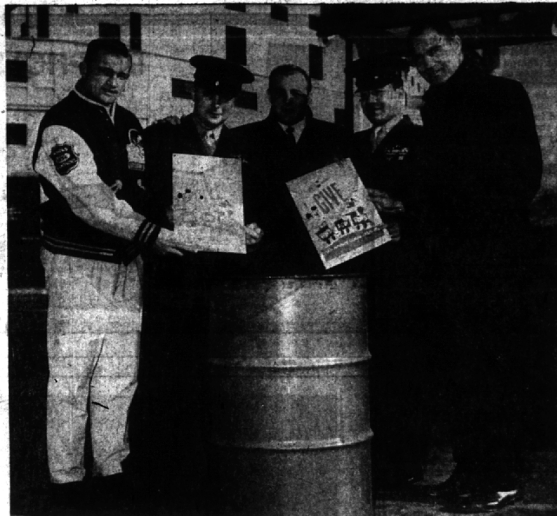

Troy News Briefs

Troy Firemen Pick Ford as New Chief

Lauren Ford, 310 W. Wattle was chosen by Troy volunteer firemen to be their new chief. The appointment was confirmed by the city commissioners. Ford, 46, is a charter member of the volunteer force, organized in 1940. He was formerly in charge of station three, Sixteen-Mile and Delemere. He succeeds Elmer W. Schroeder, who resigned recently after 12 years as chief, following a dispute

over his business dealings with the city. City Attorney Stanley E. Burke ruled it was illegal for Schroeder to sell the city fire insurance while he was chief. Ford will be paid the same token salary as Schroeder, \$400.

To Make 4th Try For More Taxes

The Troy school board is expected to make a fourth try to obtain additional taxes sometime next spring. The board tried and failed three times this year to increase operating funds through additional taxes. The new tax try will probably be made at a special election in March. The board agreed Nov. 28 to form a School Millage Election committee of about 40 members to study the school's financial plight. The new committee will include PTA, teacher, school board and general citizen representatives.

\$2,170 Additional Charge Accepted

Troy commissioners voted last week to accept another \$2,170 per year charge from the South Dale and Garbage and Rubbish Authority. The commissioners vote 4-3 to accept the charge after City Man-

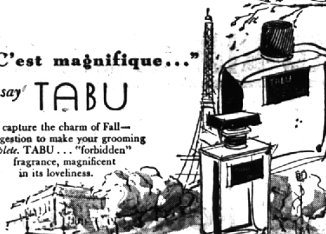

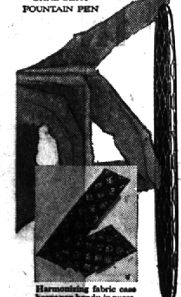
