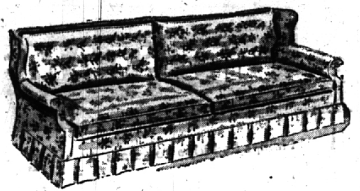

## 28th Birthday for Science Institute

BLOOMFIELD HILLS — The 28th annual report of Cranbrook Institute of Science, just published, contains the written and pictured record of an unusually active year. "In the past year," says Director Robert T. Hark, "the greatest challenge came in the increased load of community service. We met this in part by the employment of James A. Fowler as curator of education, and in part through curtailing weekend attendance by charging admission to the museum. Hark said this step was necessary because on some Sundays "so many visitors came that crowding in exhibition rooms and corridors robbed the displays of effectiveness, for visitors would often find their view of exhibits blocked, their attention distracted."

TWENTY short-term exhibits lived the year, ranging from minerals, taxidermy and slides, to Vesta the transparent talking dog who delighted herds of children. Two new educational programs were started: "Exploring Science" for junior members, and a workshop on the use of museum resources for Oakland county teachers.

There were eleven illustrated lectures and four science film programs for members, given in the auditorium of Cranbrook school. More than \$29,000 is reported in gifts from outside sources, and \$5,446 in gifts of specimens and equipment.

Mr. James Bulkeley, Chairman of the Board of Trustees who died in June, was replaced by Robert C. McMath, re-elected to the Board were Fred L. Black, Douglas Dow, H. Lynn Pearson and Chester B. Slawson.
