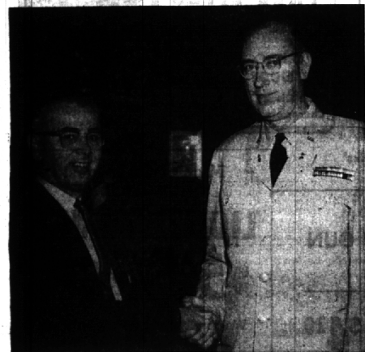

A & P SUPERMARKET START OF NEW ADAMS VILLAGE SQUARE

New Shopping Center Planned on Adams Rd.

One of the most exclusive shopping centers in the country will be built in Birmingham if current plans materialize. Realtor Jervis J. Wattles, representing the John Chiera Company, revealed that plans for the Reid Paterson property on Adams near Bowers have already been started.

The first store in the center, tentatively titled "Adams Village Square," is the A & P supermarket already under construction. There is a strip of land beside the market that measures 126 by 470 feet and is open to development. Wattles is negotiating with both local and national merchants who handle only top quality merchandise. "THESE merchants handle the better lines in soft goods and many are just waiting until other plans are completed before starting on this project," Wattles said. He expects most of the plans to be finalized within a year. One of the features of this particular center would be the off-street parking facilities.

THE NEW supermarket has parking for 170 cars and there will be nearly 600 parking spaces when it is completed. Estimated cost of the shopping area has been placed at over two million dollars.

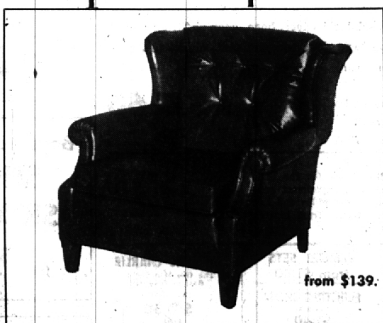

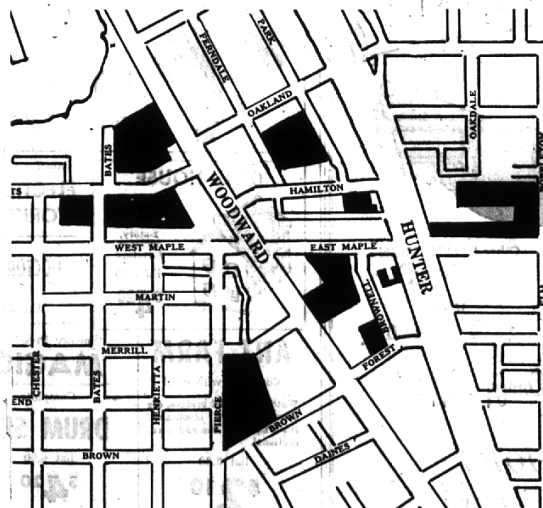
