FBI Publication Praises B'h'm Police Training

The FBI's official publication this month carries a report on Birmingham police Sgt. Richard E. Brown's quick draw last October at a local home.

In a story titled, "Firearms Training Pays Dividend," the FBI Law Enforcement bulletin describes how "the police officer's quick action in automatically assuming the hip-firing position" probably saved his life. Police say the bandit who fired on Brown missed the heart because of the officer's crouching to the left in the position firearms training taught him to use.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover wrote Birmingham Police Chief Ralph W. Motley, enclosing a copy of the publication.

"I thought you might be interested in seeing the article," Hoover wrote. "... It reflects the importance of firearms training in law enforcement."

The firearms training program is conducted by the FBI.
