Pruning is a thoughtful process designed to:-

- Remove all dead, diseased or injured wood.
- 2. Remove crossing branches to prevent rubbing and permit better penetration of light and air.
- 3. Remove weak, worn-out and crowded stems.
- Improve health of plant, quality of foliage and often abundance of bloom.
- Allow insect and fungus sprays to more effectively cover the plant.
- 6. Control growth so they stay in size and shape.
- 7. Encourage yield.
