Mrs. Don Corbacho, PTA program chairman, has asked Henry Corbacho, director of the Materials Center and assistant to the director of curriculum of the Birmingham public schools, to speak to the parents and teachers on "New Resources for Learning."

Corbacho, coming to Birmingham from Wayne State university where he was in charge of teacher training in the use of visual aids, is responsible for the distribution of all films, film strips, tapes, supplementary reading, and other audio-visual aids to the various classrooms in the Birmingham school system.

He will exhibit, demonstrate, and explain the use of many different media utilized regularly to enrich the elementary school program. A typical film used in the classroom will be shown to the parents and Corbacho will describe how it is employed to instruct.
