BUSINESS BRIEFS

Retiring American Motors Exec Responsible for Many Advances

When Meade Moore retires this month as automotive engineering and research vice-president of American Motors, he will have the good fortune to be able to look ahead to the fruition of much of his work instead of just fondly behind.

Moore, former Birmingham resident now living in Detroit, helped design the first Nash in 1917 followed this with a long string of automotive engineering firsts that make choice reading in the technical history of the industry during the past forty years. Among several advances, three major achievements identified with his name stand out most clearly: pressurized fresh air heating and ventilation, single unit body construction and tie-rod nut car. The first has been universally adopted, the latter two are in their growth stages.

Moore joined Nash in Detroit in 1917 shortly after graduation from Ohio Northern university and participated in engineering of the original Nash car, Model 681, which made its successful debut in the fall of 1917. Before college years he had been service mechanic for

two years, was bound to United Aircraft Corp. as production engineering manager at Hartford, Conn. From 1920 through 1951 he was chief automotive research engineer. In 1952 he was elected vice-president of automotive research and a year later was placed in charge of both research and engineering.

HE ASSUMED the same vice-presidential title with American Motors, following the merger of Nash-Kelvinator and Hudson in 1954.

President George Romney said Moore will continue on a consulting basis with American Motors.
