

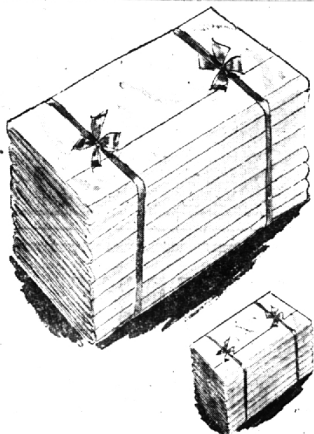

Mrs. Mona Brigant of Bloomfield township lost \$23,000 when she laid a handbag containing the sum down somewhere in Northland shopping center.

Pro-village forces in Westwood overcame a heavy anti-village vote in West Beverly Hills subdivision to bring the 1½-square-mile area its own honorific village. In another Southfield township area, voters pushed through their wishes to incorporate into the City of Southfield.

A petition requesting council to either repeal the downspout disconnection ordinance or put the question on a ballot was received by Lathrup officials.

ISSUE OF SEPTEMBER 26

Pettitioners in Troy asked a referendum be called for the purpose of reducing the city's 20-mill tax limitation to 15 mills.

Three Bloomfield township traffic accidents in one day resulted in injuries to six persons.

Westwood's newly elected charter commission held its first meeting at which the five-man commission was given the oath of office.

Lathrup residents learned they might have to pay for a \$300,000 bond issue without voting on whether or not they wanted their taxes raised.

Southfield township's parks and recreation commission asked the township board to inquire as to the possibility of securing 99½ acres for a park site.

ISSUE OF OCTOBER 3

A masked bandit was killed by Birmingham police sergeant Richard E. Brown after Brown had been shot in the side by the intruder at the home of John S. VanAlystine, Jr., 515 Kenneway. Four or five shots fired by Brown in the snufflight on the front staircase of

the VanAlystine home struck the holiday man, identified by police as Frank Pruhn, about 60, of no permanent address.

City Manager L. E. Gave announced that Birmingham's volunteer fire department would become an auxiliary effective July 1, 1958. Gave said the city's fire department no longer required supplementation by regular part-paid volunteers. The first time volunteer firemen were called out was in June of 1954.
