Dessert Luncheon Set for Friday

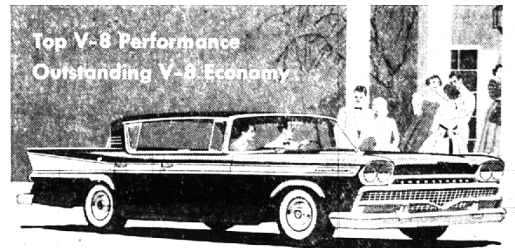

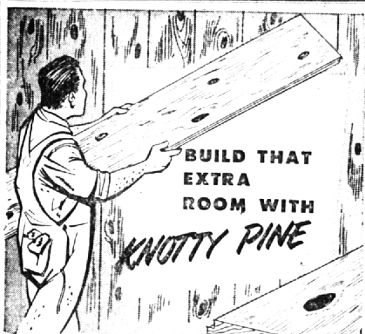

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election will be held in Bloomfield Hills School District No. 2, County of Oakland, Michigan, on Monday, January 20, 1958, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., Eastern Standard Time, for the purpose of voting on the following propositions:

PROPOSITION I—Old Hickory Grove School Building and Site Proposition

Shall the Board of Education of Bloomfield Hills School District No. 2, County of Oakland, Michigan, be authorized to dispose of the Old Hickory Grove School Building and Site which are no longer needed for school purposes?

PROPOSITION II—Eastover School Site Proposition

Shall the Board of Education of Bloomfield Hills School District No. 2, County of Oakland, Michigan, be authorized to dispose of a portion of the Eastover School Site consisting of a parcel of land approximately 150 feet by 150 feet on the westerly edge of the Eastover School Site which is no longer needed for school purposes?

- A resident of the State of Michigan for six months and of the School District for thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election;

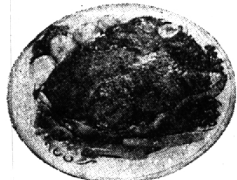
