INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE RECORDS GROWN

CRANBROOK — Dr. Robert T. Hatt, Director of Cranbrook Institute of Science, has just released his 1957 annual report, which shows big growth in every aspect of the Institute's work and service.

For instance, 1957's visitor count was 124,000, a rise from 95,878 the year before, while visiting groups increased from 1,404 to 2,108. The planetarium gave 855 demonstrations, almost double last year's number, with 48,458 people attending.

The Institute sent out four major expeditions in 1957: the coral reef expedition to the Bahaman islands to obtain data and material for the coral reef exhibition now in process; the British Honduran expedition conducted by Karl D. Bailey who, with the help of Honduran personnel made zoological collections along the coast for later institute exhibitions; the expedition to Central America made by John W. Mulford, Detroit industrialist, and Dr. Frederick H. Pough, mineralogist, for an educational film on 18 active volcanoes, which they photographed from the air.

Going to Europe

Getting the finishing touches on his roommate before inspection is Patrick Jeffrey Ott, pictured at the U. S. Army information school, Fort Slocum, N. Y. FOURTH OF THE expeditions was a search for plants of the Gaillardia group growing in northern Mexico and the southwestern states, conducted by Dr. Warren P. Stoutamire, Detroit hotelier at the institute, with the assistance of Carl Stone of the University of Michigan.

The Institute also set up 30 special exhibitions ranging from Detroit-made diamonds to underwater painting and Japanese fish prints; nine lectures on natural history subjects; and three film programs; put out 21 publications, and conducted six TV programs over channel 56 for the Detroit educational television foundation.

Institute Director Dr. Hatt spent three months of the past fiscal year in Pakistan where he was invited by UNESCO to help set up a series of natural history museums to promote basic education. He conducted educational surveys over much of western and eastern Pakistan and submitted plans for development of museums of science and technology.


