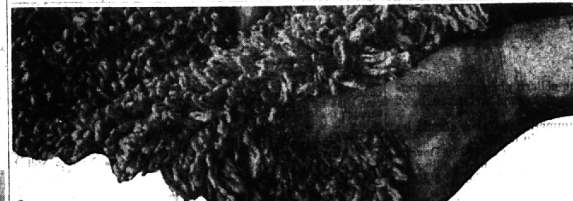

A new idea to discourage barnacles from settling on ships' hulls has recently been tried out successfully. Ultrasonic vibrations, induced through a transducer into the ship's plates, have been found to make the hull an uncomfortable place for barnacles to settle. Nickel plates used in the transducer are primarily responsible for creating the ultrasonic vibrations due to the fact that nickel changes in dimensions when magnetized and reverts to its original size when demagnetized. When this is done at high frequency, vibrations are produced from the nickel plates. These vibrations do not affect passengers, crew or sensitive instruments aboard the ship, nor are they injurious to the barnacles.
