Parties Original

There's nothing so original about a hay-ride and yet it can be the focal point of one of the most gay parties that you can give. Hayrides used to be fairly common but the day seems to be fast approaching when they are a novelty.

You do not need a friend or relative to be a farmer to supply the equipment. Most riding stables can accommodate you with the wagon, horses and driver for a nominal fee.

A HAYRIDE can be fun for all ages from about ten on to adults. If it is a children's party, they will get lots of fun out of your hiding pennies in the hay. You might also scatter balloons (although you should check with the driver before you do the latter as if the balloons burst, it might scare the horses).

For an adult or teens party, it is fun to have someone along with an accordion, a banjo or ukule so that the group can sing as they ride.

It is fun, returning to the home of the host and hostess for a dawn breakfast of pancakes, sausages and hot coffee.

Before you issue your guest list, it is wise to check with the stable to determine how many they can carry on the wagon. If it is a children's party, they could take more.

GUESTS should be advised of the nature of the party and told to wear jeans or appropriate sports attire.

For a children's party, at least two or three adults should accompany them as they need control to a certain extent and the driver cannot do this alone.

EVENING or very early morning is best for the hayride as it is the cool of the day for both you and the horses. If you want to put on a really different party, set the time for about 7 a.m. and ride for an hour to some chosen spot where you stop and cook bacon and eggs over an open fire and then ride back.

For an all boys party, perhaps it would be fun to ride to an open field, hold a baseball game and then ride back. Have a hot-dog supper upon their return with plenty of cokes and individual berry tarts for dessert.

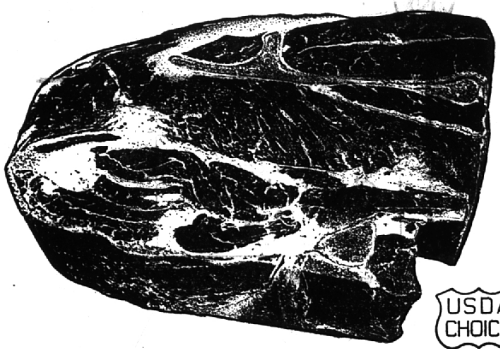
