New Hills Apartments
Encompass 8-Acre Area

Opened for its first occupants in April, the 24-unit Bloomfield Hills apartments now have 10 units occupied and the remainder ready for use.

The eight buildings, 2400 N. Woodward at Hickory Grove, encompass an eight-acre area with a private entrance off Hickory Grove.

Interior decor of the apartments was planned and designed by Herbert Chernick, who supervised the construction. A University of Michigan graduate, Chernick has a background of almost 30 years of building of this type in the Detroit area.

THE THREE and four-bedroom

homes have all the appointments of the old-fashioned mansion, with each apartment equipped with many modern devices.

To serve the apartment, Chernick had installed 4,000 feet of water mains, 10,000 gallons of water storage, two wells, 4,500 feet of 12 to 20-inch sewer main and an \$80,000 disposal plant. Cost of the units has been estimated at from \$35,000 to \$65,000 each.

A cooperative purchase plan is available to those desiring ownership.

Management is by Michaels Realty with a resident manager at the apartments.

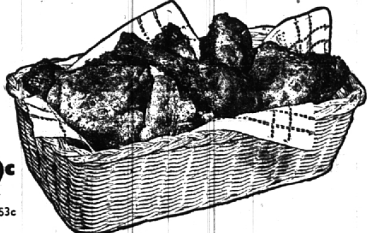
