How Do You Like the Plans for Northwestern Expressway?

What's your reaction to this proposed route for Northwestern highway from Southfield's south city limits to M-59? The state highway department will have a hearing at 1:30 p.m. Aug. 11 at Southfield high school to find out. The section from 8 Mile to Telegraph is scheduled to be underway next year and cost about \$27 million. Beginning at 8 Mile the limited access road will be elevated to 8 1/2'. As far as Orchard Lake road an additional 114 feet of right of way will be purchased to provide future widening. The highway

will use the present 204-foot Northwestern right of way. The design calls for two 36-foot concrete pavements making six lanes. The existing Northwestern will become a one-way service road going southeast, and a new one-way northbound service road will be built from 8 Mile to Orchard Lake road. The expressway through Oakland county will connect with the John Lodge expressway in Detroit.

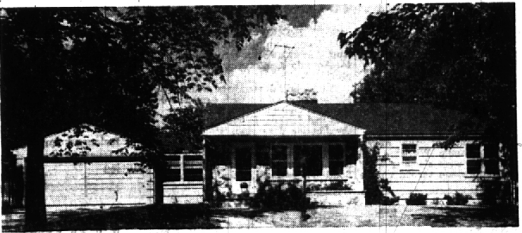
