Broomfield Seeks Re-election As Congressman

WASHINGTON—Oakland county's Congressman, William S. Broomfield, today announced he will seek re-election on the Republican ticket this November. Broomfield, representative of one of the largest congressional districts in the Nation, said he will continue to work for "all the people of Oakland county." The 18th district congressman is a member of the powerful public

works committee and subcommittees on rivers and harbors and Federal buildings. He led the fight against "spook barrel" projects in the rivers and harbors omnibus bill which was later vetoed by President Eisenhower. Summer Theatre Schools Offer Scholarships Here

Two area summer theatre schools announced scholarships this week. Cranbrook summer theatre school Director Carl G. Wonnberger said the school would award four full working scholarships for boys 17 or over who are experienced in theatre work. Will-O-Way apprentice theatre announced four work scholarships for the summer term they will be awarded after try-outs for the open competition Saturday, June 21, at 1 p.m. at the apprentice theatre, Long Lake road at Tele-

graph. Wonnberger said 12 scholarships have already been awarded at the theatre school which opens June 23 in the Greek theatre, Cranbrook. He said the additional scholarships are offered to balance the heavy enrollment of regular students in the senior division.

SCHOLARSHIP students receive regular tuition and all swimming privileges without charge and may participate in all plays in return for assistance in staging and

maintenance. The seven and a half week course may be taken for credit under certain conditions, Wonnberger said. Will-O-Way is offering one scholarship in a four-week recreation program which combines drama and recreation. The competitive age group is six years through 13 years. The scholarships are offered for a seven-week regular theatre course, one for a 14 to 18-year-old, and one to an adult over 18. The fourth scholarship will be offered to a college student for an eight-week university course. Registrations for the Will-O-Way programs are being accepted through June 22.
