Ike Aide Speaks Here, Calls for 'A New Humanism'

CRANBROOK - Arthur Larson, special assistant to President Eisenhower, assailed the trend toward "coasting into mediocrity" in an address he delivered Saturday to the graduating class at Cranbrook School, Bloomfield Hills.

The presidential aide came out strongly against over-specialization in education without a proper liberal arts background, and urged the school seniors not to be afraid or ashamed of being idealistic.

"And the ideal that should be put forth to the world is not one of a particular government or political mechanism, but rather, 'A New Humanism' which is based on the principle of supplying fresh idealism and a fresh driving force toward new heights."

"LEON THOTSON, who was mistaken about a lot of things, got one thing right when he said: 'Anyone desiring a quiet life here should be born in Cranbrook, Michigan.'"
